Re: Proposition 65 Warning Statement

Dear Valued Customer,

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 known at Proposition 65 was adopted by the State of California with intent to protect drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm and to inform its citizens of potential exposures to these chemicals from products.

Proposition 65 list of chemicals is reviewed annually, and chemicals are added and/or removed upon this review. November 17 and December 29, 2023, **OEHHA** updated the toxicity of four substances on the California Proposition 65 which are not in our scope of distribution. This list currently contains approximately 900 known chemicals, since first published in 1987 and requires consumer products to have a warning label if containing listed chemicals unless the seller has testing data that proves the product meets it exposure level standards as outlined by Proposition 65.

As a distributor, Wyatt Seal, Inc., does not manufacture nor test products for known chemicals and must rely on information provided by our suppliers to determine if Proposition 65 chemicals are present along with testing data to prove the product meets exposure levels. We largely distribute products in rubber and plastics with some silicones, brass, and metal products which are known to contain small amounts of chemicals listed on Proposition 65 such as: Benz[a]antracene 56-55-3, Benzo[b]fluorantened 205-99-2, Benzo[j]fluoranthene 205-82-3, Benzo[k]fluoranthene 207-08-9, Benzo[a]pyrene 50-32-8. Chrysene 218-01-9, Dibenz[a,h]anthracene 53-70-3 to list a few as found in rubber as well as Indeno [1,2,3-c,d]pyrene(CAS No.: 193-39-5)

Wyatt Seal, Inc. has adopted the policy that any product we ship to California should be labeled with a warning label to identify any potential exposure as required by Proposition 65. This policy is an outgrowth from gathered information of our supply chain which shows most products supplied to us have one or more chemicals present within the product or added in the processes to make them; furthermore, our major suppliers are not testing for the presence of chemicals listed on Proposition 65 due to cost, time and difficulties obtaining information on numerous products that they manufacture.
